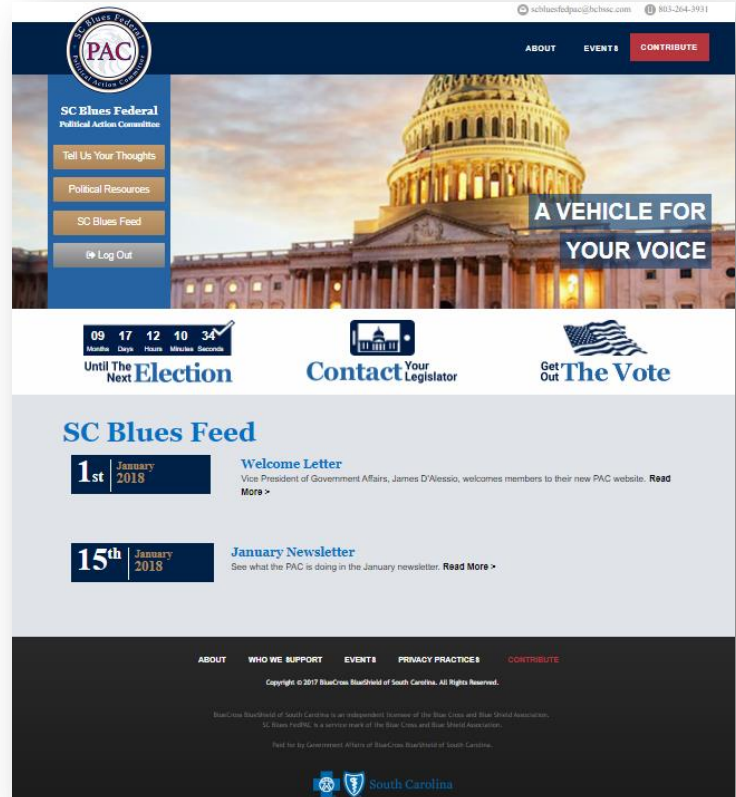
A NEW YEAR, A "NEW" PAC

The new website offers several helpful features such as seeing answers to frequently asked questions, identifying who is on the PAC board and government affairs team, seeing future legislative alerts, and a list of upcoming PAC events.

Other important features the new website offers are a SC Blues Feed where important PAC questions will be answered and updates will be provided. The website also features a countdown to the next federal election with pertinent information, information on how to contact your legislator, how to register to vote, and a way to send in your thoughts in a private, secure format.
